**GRAMMAR 7.1 GRAMMATICA 7.1**

Plural of Pronouns : Nominative Case

**Il plurale dei pronomi: caso nominativo.**

When the pronoun is the subject of a sentence, it is in the Nominative case. The plural is formed usually by taking the singular word stem and appending a form of this syllable:-

Quando il pronome è il soggetto di una frase, è nel caso nominativo. Il plurale è formato di solito prendendo la radice della parola al singolare e aggiungendo una forma di questa sillaba:-

“-রা” “-raa”

Plural of Pronouns: Possessive Case (See also Grammar 5.2)

**Pronomi plurali: caso genitivo o possessivo** (vedi anche *sezione Grammatica 5.2*)

A Possessive is used when the pronoun is the possessor of another person or thing. The plural is formed usually by taking the singular word stem and appending a form of this syllable:-

Un possessivo è usato quando il pronome è il possessore di un'altra persona o cosa. Il plurale è formato di solito prendendo la radice della parola al singolare e aggiungendo una forma di questa sillaba:-

“-দের” “-der”

In effect, you just take the final syllable of the singular form of the possessive pronoun and insert this element:-

Di fatto, puoi prendere la sillaba finale della forma singolare del pronome possessivo e inserire questo elemento:-

“-দে” “-de”

The verb form is the same in the plural as for the singular.
